Tony will read because he is a responsible stand-up type of guy, but he isn't very excited about the task. He views it the same as completing chores...a necessary task. Here is how you can tell if you may have an *Apathetic Annie and Only Because I Have to Tony* in your class.

Clues You Have an *Apathetic Annie & If I Have to Tony*:

If it is a stamina issue :

- You notice this student talking to others, looking around, flipping through the book, tinkering with objects around them instead of reading
- They are not reaching [Reading Goal](#).

If it is a "reads just to read" issue:

- The student is reading, but there is no excitement
- When you [confer](#), they have no passion
- They don't like to share their thoughts about their book during share time.

How You Can Help *Apathetic Annie & If I Have to Tony*:

- Build [Reading Stamina](#). It needs to be a habit
- The goal is to find what these students are passionate about. When you find that passion, their "reading light will ignite."
- Check in often through [Reading Conferences](#) to see what the issue is.
