



Too Simple Sara & Too Challenging Charlie's Reading Profile

This is *Too Simple Sara* and *Too Challenging Charlie*. Sara and Charlie do not read books at their "Just Right" level. Here is how you can tell if you may have a *Too Simple Sara* or a *Too Challenging Charlie* in your class.

Clues You Have a *Too Simple Sara* & *Too Challenging Charlie*:

- The student is not engaged in the book they are reading.
- They may look confused or move through the book too quickly.
- You know your student's reading level and as you confer or take their [Reading Status](#), you notice that the student is not reading books at their level.

How You Can Help *Too Simple Sara* & *Too Challenging Charlie*:

- Teach students to do the [5 Finger Test](#).
- Too Simple: Teach students to challenge themselves and give them lots of encouragement.
- Too Challenging: Help students find a familiar book at their level. Check in with students often through [reading conferences](#).
- Have students refer to their ["TBR" List](#) to choose books.
